What is judiciary's place in the structure of Bangladesh?

Establishment of Supreme Court

Article 94 of the Constitution of Bangladesh states about the establishment of Supreme Court, it's divisions-i.e. about Appellate Division and High Court Division. According to this article of the constitution the highest court of Bangladesh shall be known Supreme Court of as Bangladesh. [Source]

Appointment of Chief Justice and other Judges

Article 94 states that the Supreme Court shall be headed by Chief Justice of Bangladesh and according to article 95 of the constitution the Chief Justice of Bangladesh shall be appointed by the President and other Judges shall be appointed by President after consultation with Chief Justice. [Source]

Control over sub-ordinate courts

Article 109 of the constitution states that High Court Division shall have superintendence and control over all courts and tribunals subordinate to it.

Establishment of Subordinate Court

Provisions for establishment of subordinate Court has been stated in article 114 of the Constitution of Bangladesh. Article 115 states that judicial officers for subordinate court shall be appointed by President of Bangladesh. [Source]
